

Configuring the Microsoft Messenger:mac Client for Microsoft Office Communications Server 2007 R2

This document goes through the steps required for setting up the Microsoft **Messenger:mac** on an Apple Mac computer that has Mac OS X version 10.4.9 (Tiger) or a later version of Mac OS installed. This document assumes that you already have **Messenger:mac** installed and running as pictured below

Please note: The current **Messenger:mac** client is 7.0.2. If you have an earlier version, please download and install this version from the Wiki:

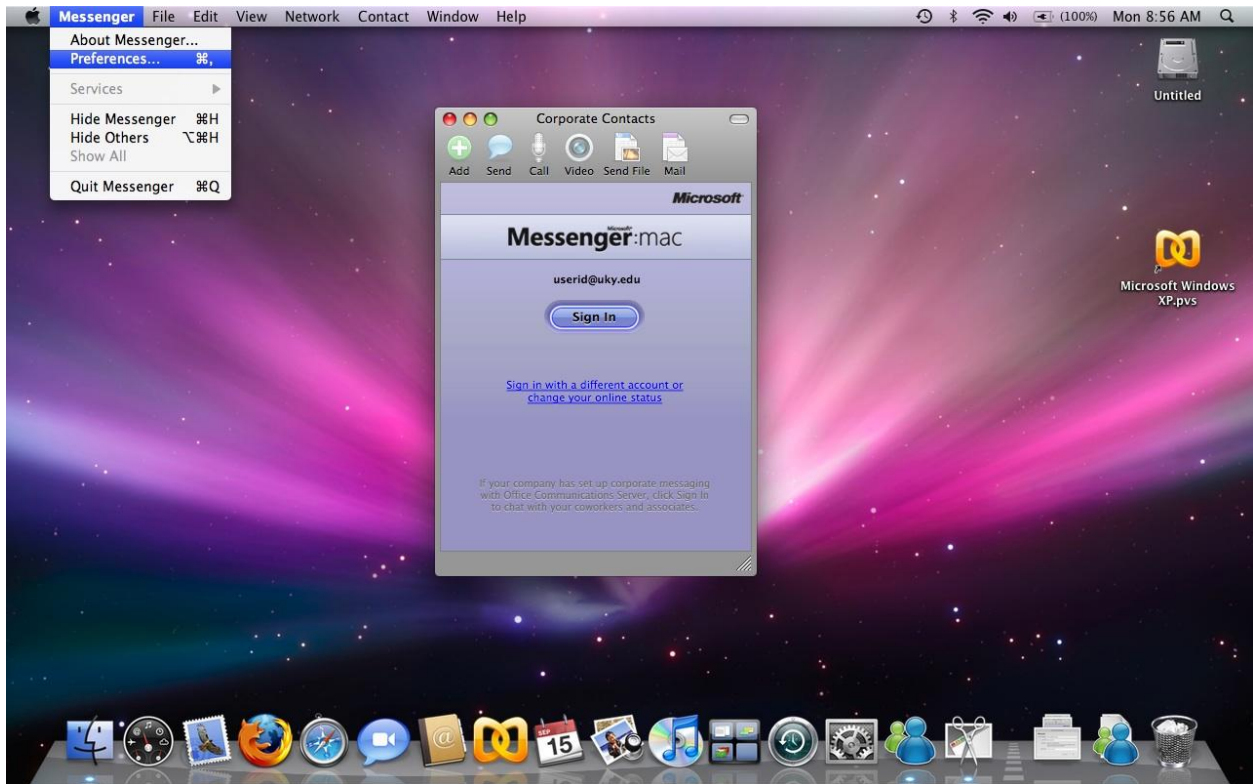

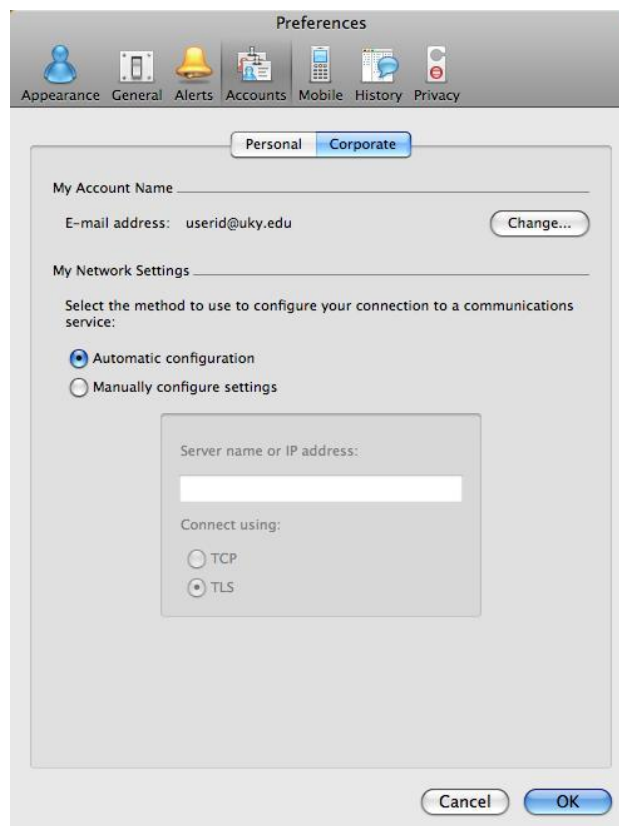


1. Go to the Messenger Menu bar and choose Preferences.



2. On the *Preferences* dialog box, click *Accounts* make sure that the *Corporate* tab is highlighted then select the “Automatic Configuration” radio button and click “OK”.



- Next, click the  button under the *My Account Name* section on the Corporate Accounts Preferences page. This brings up the *Corporate Settings* dialog box shown below. In the line where it says *E-mail address*, you want to put in your OCS Sign-in address which is your `userid@uky.edu` **NOT** your email address! Then enter your Active Directory credentials which are `AD\userid` or `MC\userid` and your password in the *User ID* and *Password* boxes respectively.
